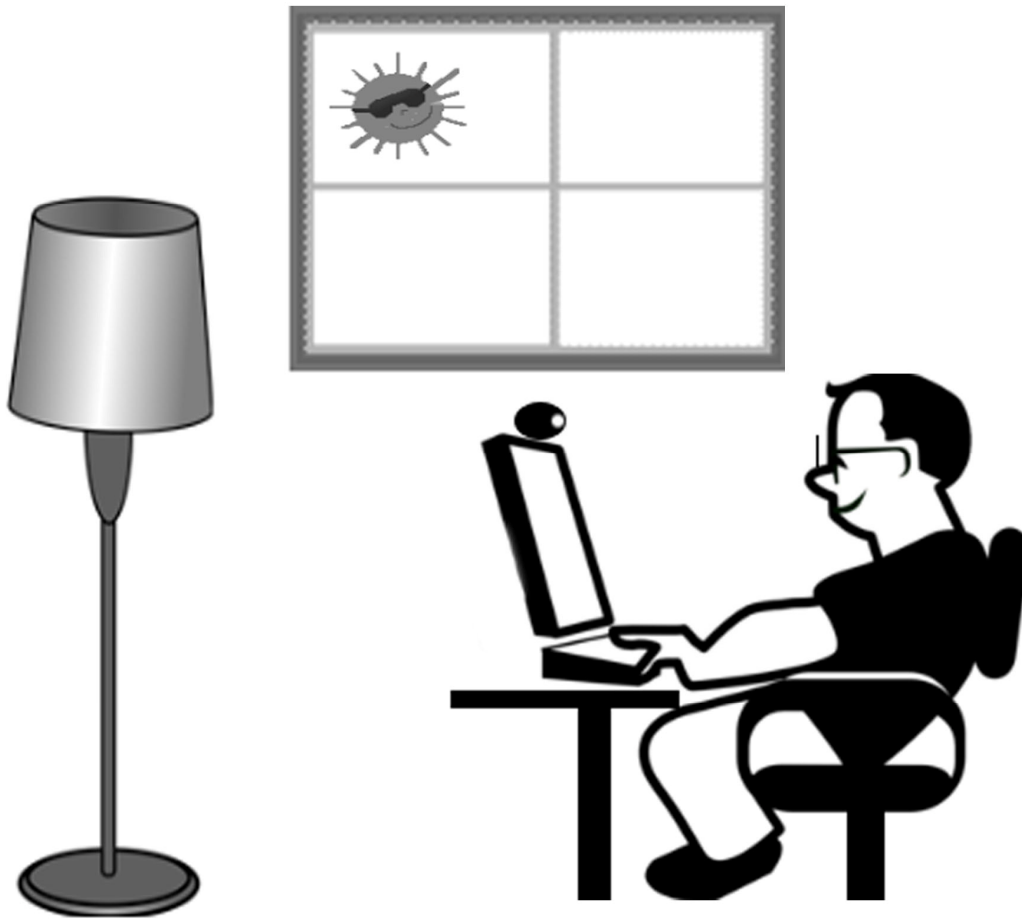


How to set up a room for your video call.



- 1. Position your web camera so your background is a solid color. It is best if there is nothing in the background to distract from you being the center of the image. A solid, light color wall works well.**
- 2. Position yourself to take advantage of natural light coming in a window. This helps your camera pick up your image as the full light spectrum hits your face.**
- 3. Turn on an incandescent light behind the camera. This will serve to fill in any shadows and help keep you from looking two-dimensional. Do not use florescent lights, as they will serve to deaden your image.**
- 4. Turn off anything that will cause noise. A/C units etc. You need a quiet room to help your video be professional. (lock the door to the room you are using).**
- 5. Smile, you are ready to record your video.**
